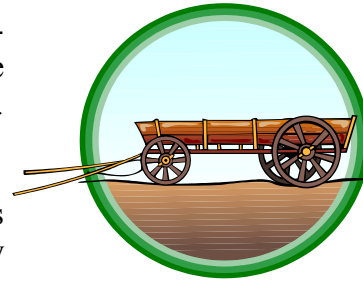

The first president to decorate the white house Christmas tree in the United States was Franklin Pierce.
