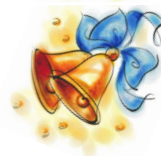

- c. We also discussed the interest in going to Helldorado Days for the October overnighiter. By a show of hands, there was a lot of interest in this outing.
- d. Memorial Day—Allen Elvick reported for Ron Uhle. It was a beautiful day and there was very good participation (18-Model A's and one-Model T). The cars were well received by the attendees at Tucson Estates. There were a couple of minor hiccups, one member ran out of gas and one had a flat tire but all were fixed in time for the parade. 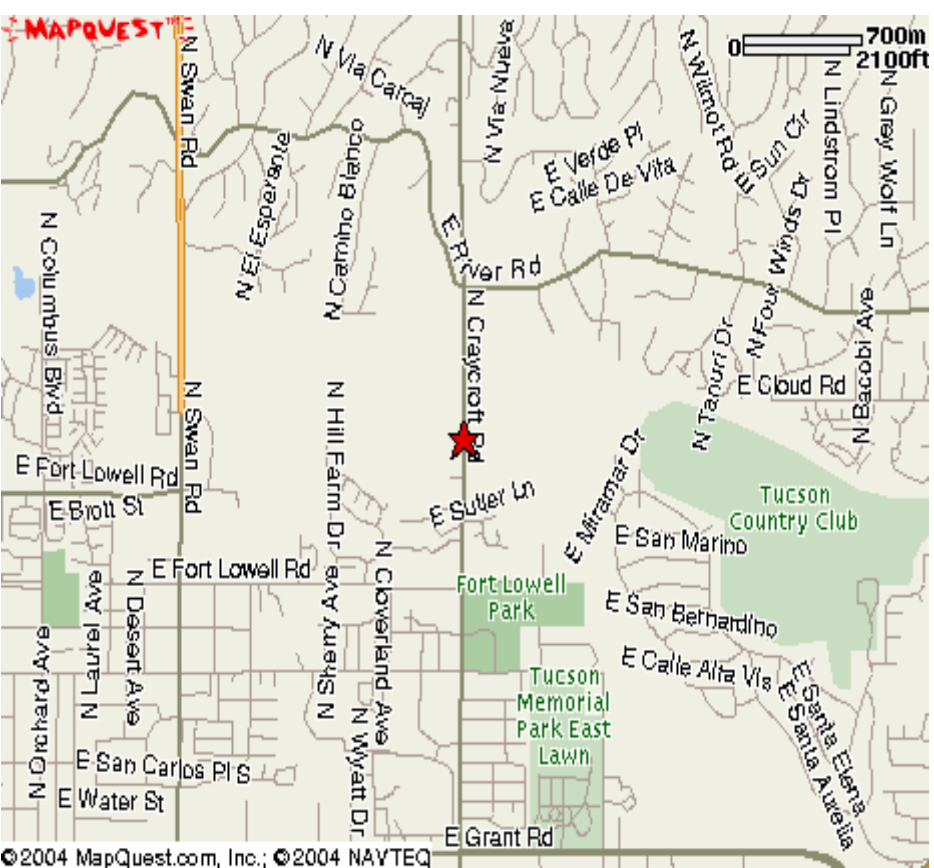
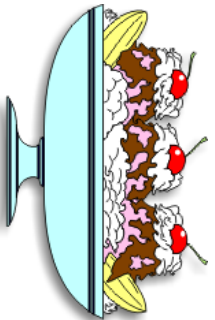

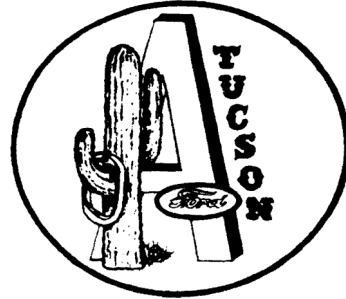
