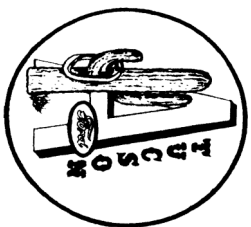

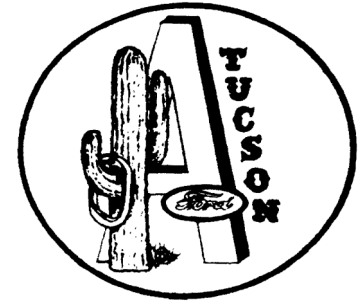

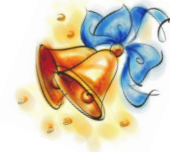
A special thanks to Jeff Epley for getting us involved with the Pima County Fair. Many thanks to all the members that brought their vehicles out for display.

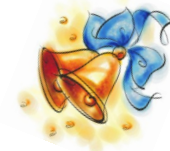

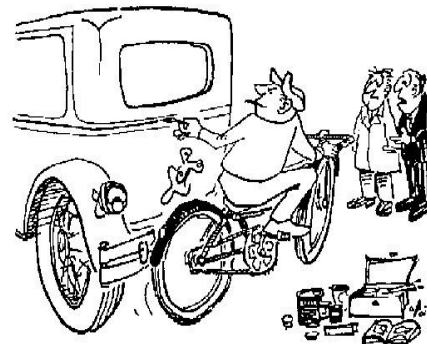

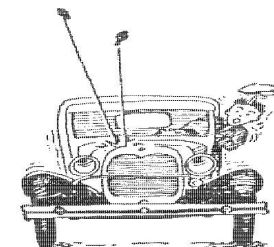

- h. Virginia Doty reported that Harold Missimer is in failing health. Cards would be welcomed.

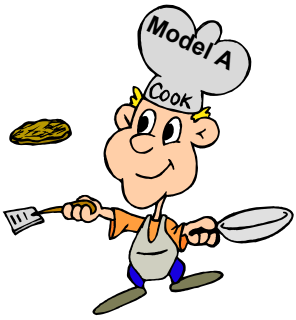

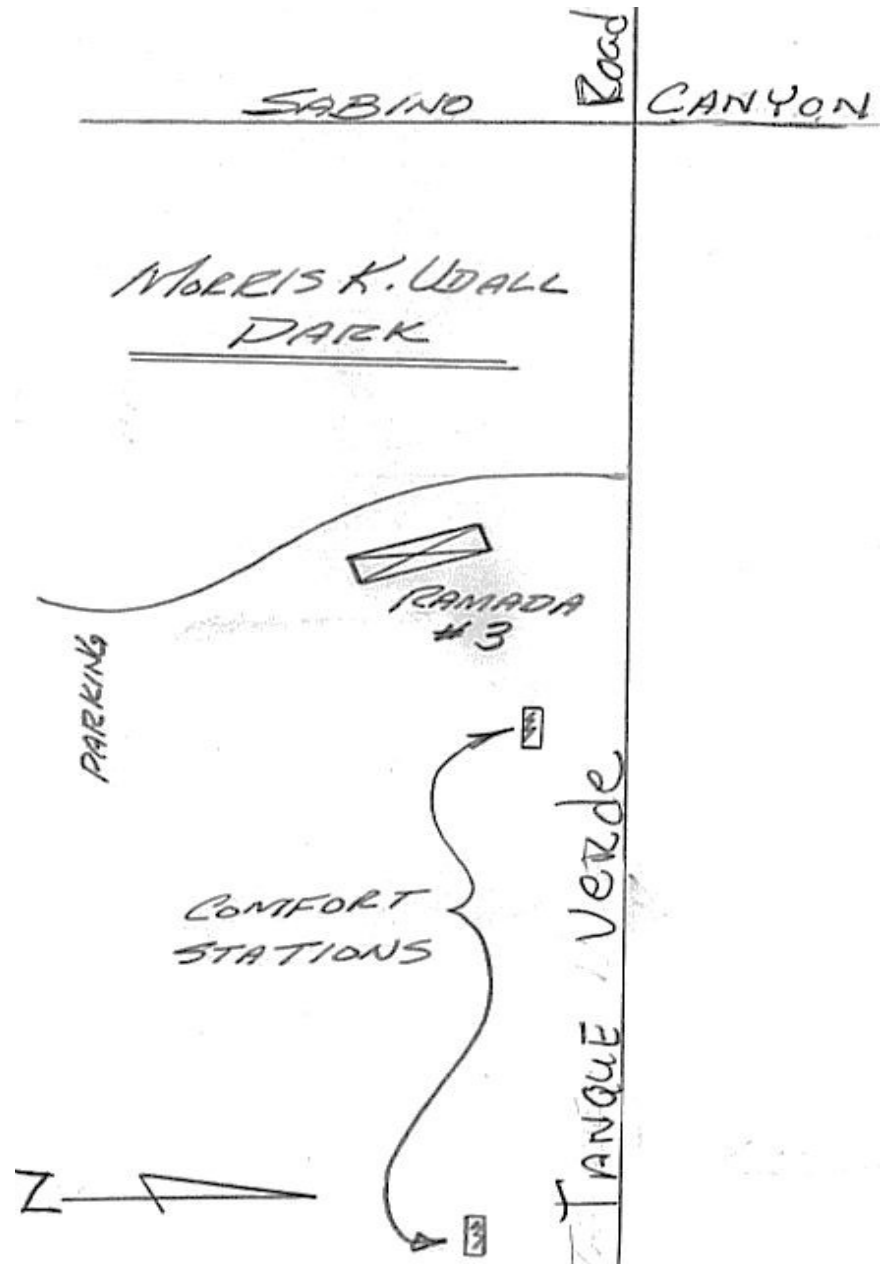
