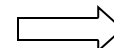
There was a great horseshoe tournament, lots of bird watching, exploring around the area, long walks (right Gary and Laura?) and just a great time visiting with our Model A family.

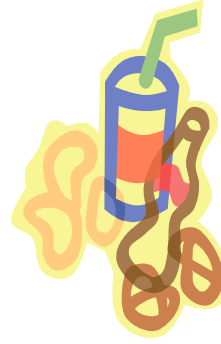

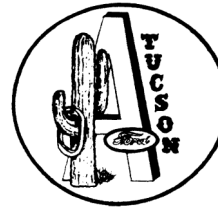
