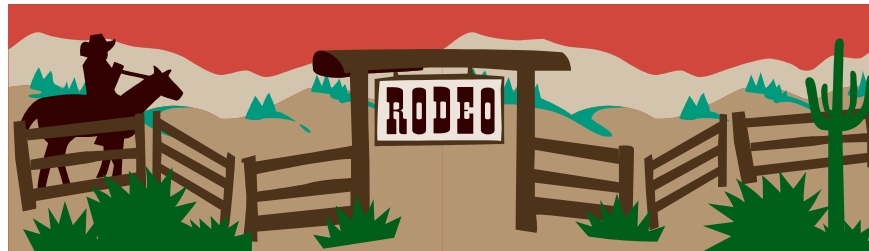
Chapter Chatter:
