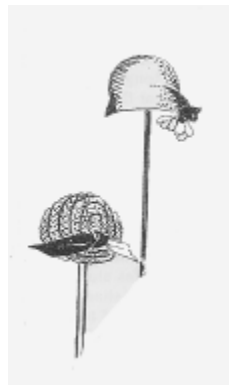

March 2, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Nancy Frazer at 7:30 PM.

The treasurer's report was given and approved by a vote of the membership. Dues for 2010 are due.

Correspondence: Various correspondence, newsletters, and information about upcoming swap meets were received from various Model A national and regional conventions.

Old Business:

Feb. outing (Ron Uhle) – There were 10 Model As, a couple of older cars, and 43 people with two guests that attended the White Elephant Sale. We collected \$652 (including a \$50 donation) for our treasury. A big thanks to the Uhles, Elvicks, Beebes and all of the helpers” that made it a success. It was a fun day.
