The weather was perfect and the food at all the stops was wonderful.

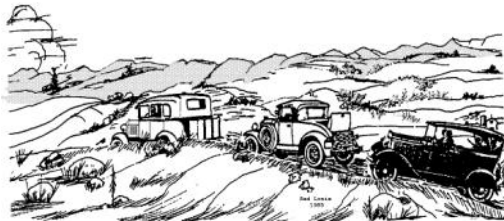
