

The Treasurer's report was given and approved as read.

Old Business:

August Outing – Mt. Lemmon outing – There were 47 people attending with 5 Model A's, 1 '35 V-8, and 1 '27 Model T. There was lots of good food and good times had by all. Thanks to everyone who participated and especially to co-chairs, Chuck and Lynn Thim for doing all the legwork and hauling all of the goodies up and down the mountain. September Outing – Ron Edwards reported that International Model A Day is September 18. Meet at Micha's (4th Ave. just North of I-10) for breakfast at about 7:30 and then leave for the Casa de los Nino's (Speedway and 4th Ave.) where we will have a show. We will then go down to the main Fire Station (10:30) to see the restored antique fire engine. We will park inside the station fence on Cushing Street.

October Overnighter - October 22 – 24 – Carl & Pat Gremmler Memorial Overnighter - Meet on Friday morning for breakfast at Micha's. Leave Mission Library (Ajo and Mission Road) at 9:00, tour to San Xavier, then to Green Valley. Suggested hotel is the Windermere. Rates = \$79.00 non-refundable or \$89 refundable if cancellation is needed. Or, there are several suggested activities; some that are only available on Saturday are: Mesquite Saw Mill, ASARCO Mineral Museum, and Santa Cruz Spice Co. Other possible activities for Friday include Wisdom's Café, Missile Site, Green Valley Pecan Company, Tumacacori Mission and Tubac. More details will be available at the general meeting.

There were several very interesting war stories told about happenings in Vancouver. Our club donated a \$100 gift certificate to the convention.

New Business:

Hill-climb - Nov. 7. Fred Secker will be in charge and we need a report from him. Ads have been placed in magazines. Nancy confirmed that Fritz will do the cooking. Ron will plan a tour for Saturday. See if Chuck would like to lead the group to TFD Station 1 to see the restored fire engine. It may also include a tour of Ernie William's garage. We will need some help to transport the food and help with the meet. Plan to be there about 7:30 a.m. We will need someone to shuttle people from the parking area to the spot for the Hill-climb.

Hayride – Betty Trimble provided two options for the Wagon-ride" on November 28. Choices: Option 1: Fred's Arena off of Ajo and Kinney road about 13 miles. Several food choices and a "Wagon Museum" to view. There is a ½ mile of dirt road. Option 2: Rocking K Ranch on Old Spanish Trail. Both would be about 45 – 60 minutes and cost approximately \$20 per person. The club selected Fred's Arena. Time of day: Mid-day. The club voted to opt for the Chicken and Steak and the club will bring the side dishes and dessert. Need to know if that includes beverages. A motion was made and passed to reimburse Betty for water and other incidentals.






