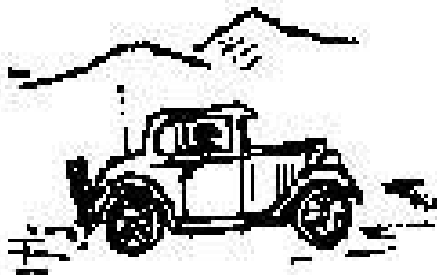


**Where:** Meet at the library parking lot at Ajo and Mission. We will drive to Tucson Estates together.

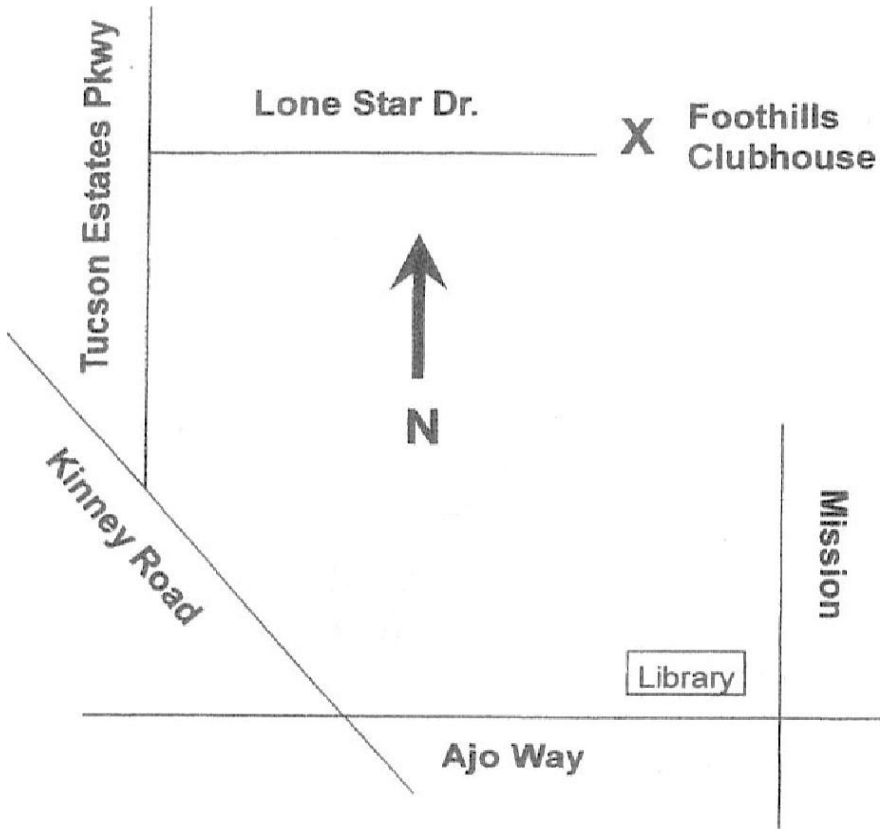




# Tucson Estates Club House


