**What to Bring:** a healthy appetite and a chair (there are picnic tables, but not always enough)

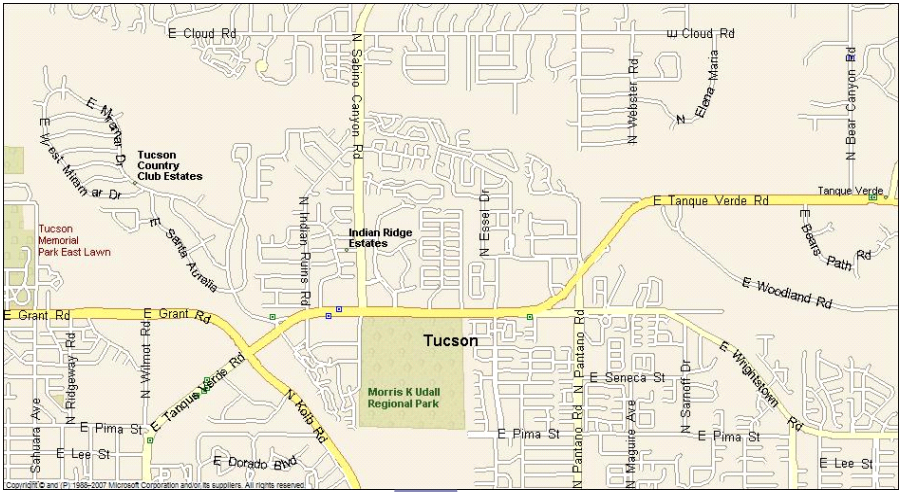

Our thanks go to Si and Millie Burgheimer, and Sam Logan and Linda Wilmore for our refreshments.

Name-badge fines were collected and will be given as a door prize at the January 2012 general meeting.

The Treasurer's report was given and approved as read.

Correspondence: The Phoenix Model A Clubs' newsletters, Food Bank, Model A Museum, Cancer Society, and several business solicitations

The door prize, a "Family" Picture frame, was won by Lynn Thim. Thanks to the Roberts for the donation. We need members to contribute door prizes for this year if we want to continue the drawings.

#### **Old Business:**

April Outing: Progressive Dinner: Ray and Sandy Feierstein hosted the appetizers/salads (46 attendees), Joe and Kelly Findysz hosted the main course, and the Petrick's hosted the desserts. There were 13 Model As and 2 Model Ts. The food was good, fellowship even better, and a good time was had by all.

The Hill Climb was discussion continued from March. We learned that if we provide food for the event, we have to be licensed and meet inspection standards. Also we could be considered a "livery" for providing rides from the parking area to the race area, even though no money is exchanged. Jim Click provided sponsorship money for the event to the Model A Club and our only financial involvement was passing on the check to Fred Secker, the head of the Hill Climb event. The board recommended that the club continue to promote the Hill Climb with announcements and in our newsletter but not be a formal sponsor, provide financial support, food service, or shuttle service. Individual members can still participate as interested. There was a tabled motion from March to continue support as we had always done. The motion was not passed with one person voting for the motion and the remainder against. Another motion was made and seconded to withdraw formal club support of the Hill Climb, food and shuttle service. The motion carried with one vote against.

**New Business:**
