Meeting was adjourned at 8:00 pm



# **Upcoming Outings**


### November 25, 2012 - Biosphere 2 Shorty Allison

CATALINA, ARIZONA




Our tour is at 11:00 AM, and should last about 2 hours. <u>Reser-</u> vations are required for tour so be sure to sign up at the November meeting.


Two charities were selected as opportunities for members to donate at the Holiday Banquet:
