Right on Frontage Road to Chavez Siding

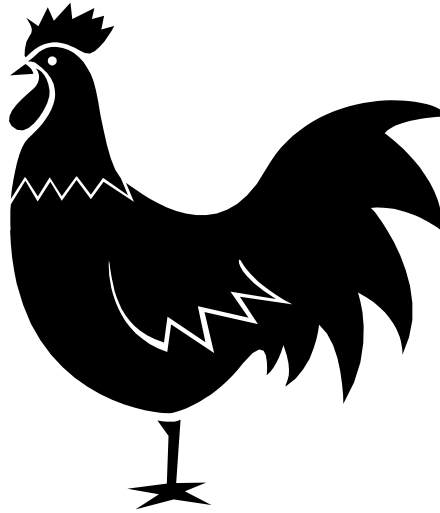
Left on Chavez Siding Rd crossing the freeway for Tubac

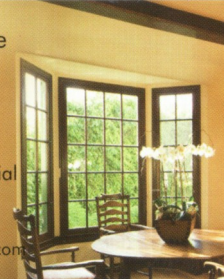
