## PIMA AIR & SPACE MUSEUM

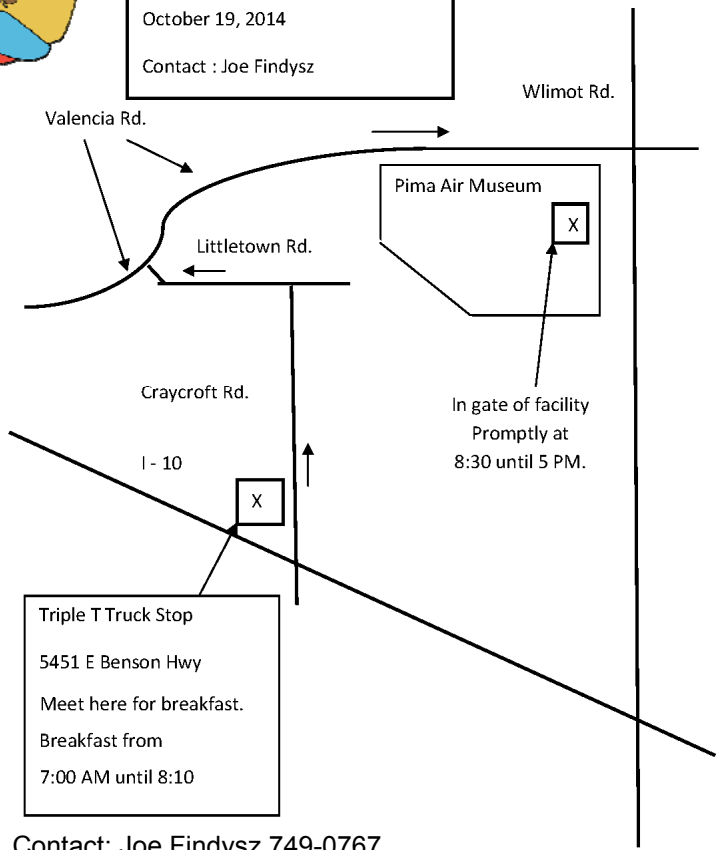
**SUNDAY OCTOBER 19**
