## Fellowship Square Saturday September 13

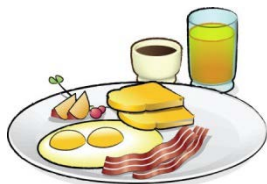
Hello Model A'ers,

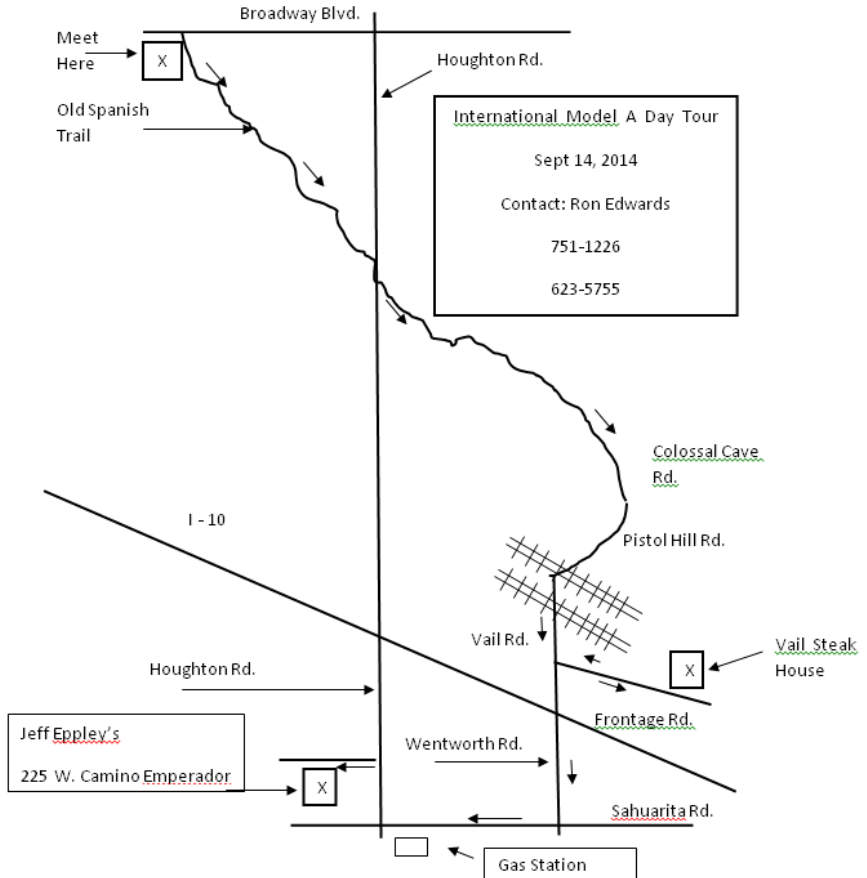

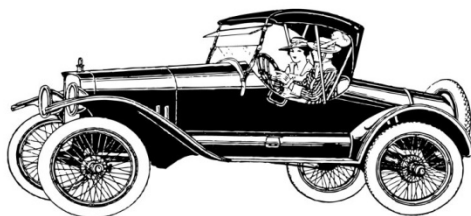


