Here are a few tidbits of information about the upcoming National Tour:

++ As of April 1st, 165 cars have been registered. Using an average of 2 persons per car, one would estimate 330 participants.

++ Eleven couples from Colorado are shipping their A's, participating in the Tour, then driving their Model A's back to Colorado. WOW, what an adventure that will be!

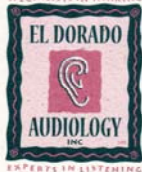
