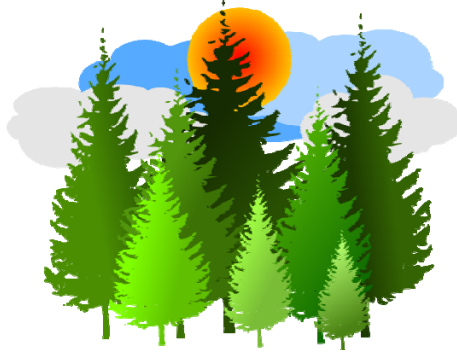

This year's lunch will again be held at the Mt. Lemmon Fire Station, with the club providing BBQ pork and drinks. Club members are asked to please bring a dish to share.

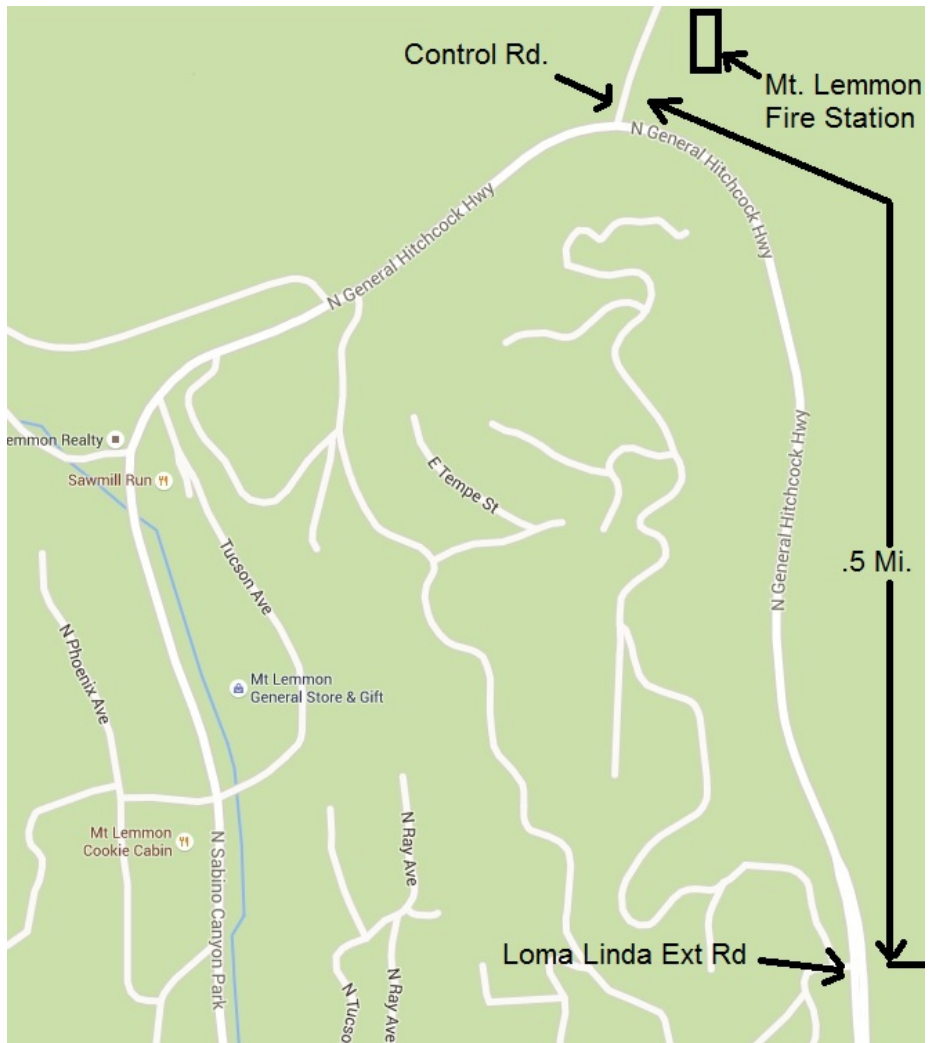
Drive up early or stay after lunch to tour Summerhaven and the roads around the village. Take the road to the ski area and enjoy all the new growth of trees and green ground cover.

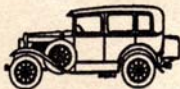

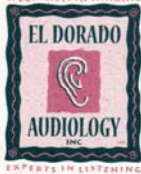
