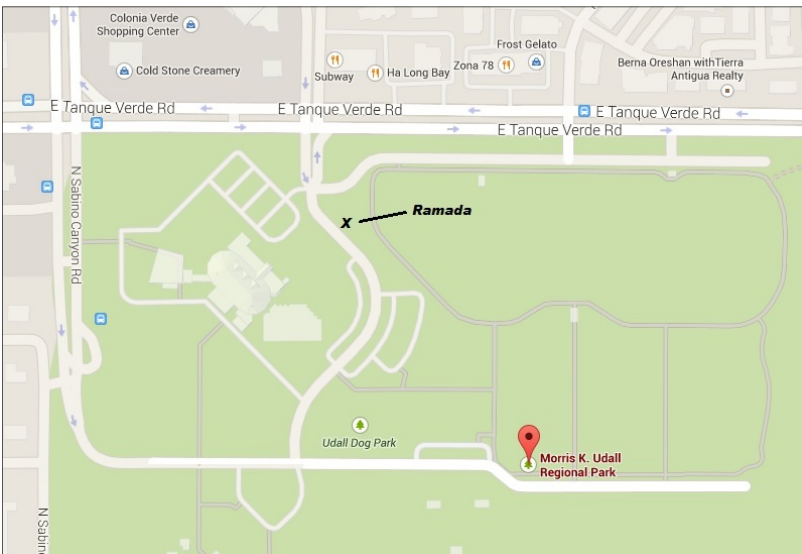
Breakfast in the Park

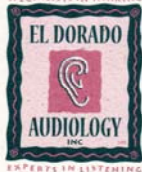
