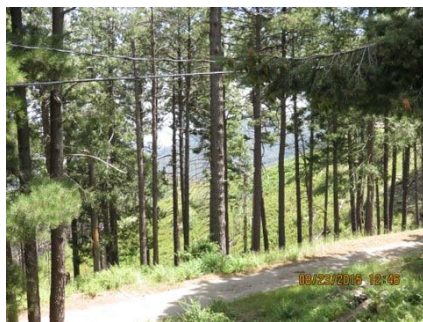

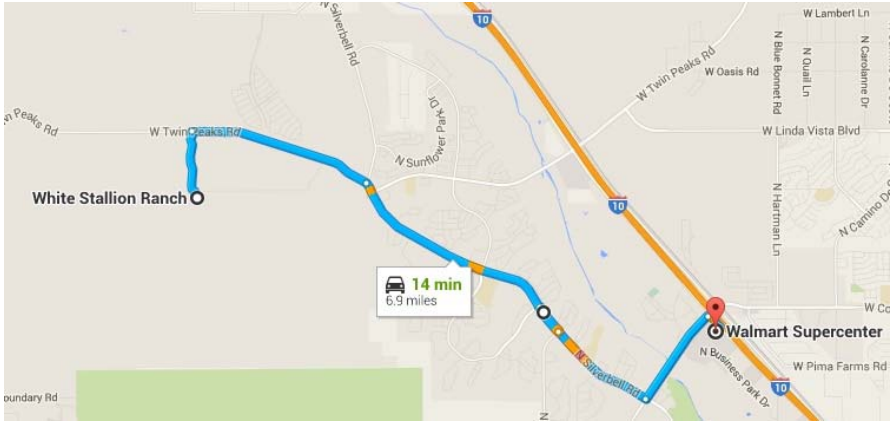

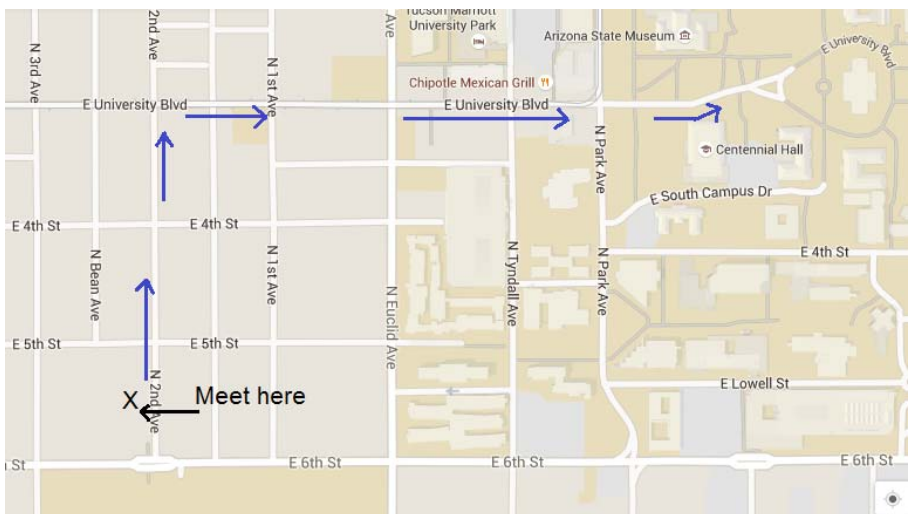
Old Main (at the U of A) Car Show

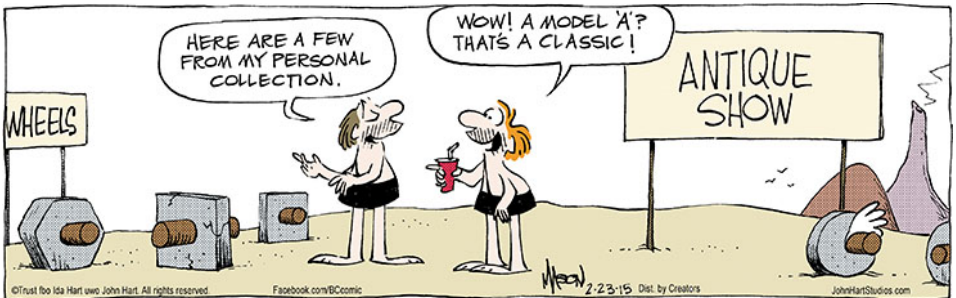
