





RASPBERRY - Voluptuous Vanilla

(Bernice Edwards' prize winning ice cream 2015)

- 2 14 oz. cans Eagle brand sweetened milk
- 2 milk cans of water
- Few grains of table type salt not a shake *
- 6 eggs, beaten
- 2 pints heavy whipping cream (4 ½ pints heavy cream = 4 cups = 1 quart)
 (can vary with half & half, or part half & half and part heavy cream)
- 2 TBS vanilla (or almond or any flavor) extract
- To Freeze: 20# crushed ice & 5-plus cups ice cream SALT (mine is a 4# box)
- 1. Combine condensed milk, water and salt* in top of double boiler (smaller pan sitting in larger pan of water on stove top). Heat over simmering water about 5 minutes whisking occasionally.
- 2. When mixture is hot, beat smooth with a wire whisk or rotary beater.
- 3. Beat a little hot milk mixture into the beaten eggs, and pour that mixture into the double boiler milk mixture slowly, so the eggs don't cook.
- 4. Cook about 5 minutes, whisking OFTEN, until slightly thickened. It will thicken more as it cools.
- Remove pan from heat, cover & chill in refrigerator several hours (or overnight).
- 6. Stir in cream & flavoring. **

**This is where you can go in any direction you choose — or let it stay an awesome voluptuous vanilla. I used any combination and quantity of fresh raspberries, frozen raspberries and raspberry puree mix. You may also add nuts. The prize winning ice cream had chopped nuts.

My technique for adding the raspberries, because I like some small bits of raspberry: I use a blender and pour some of the chilled custard mix and some raspberries and blend until it looks right. Whole raspberries can be added as you pour it into the tub to freeze it. I also prefer the nuts — any kind — rather small, but it is your choice. It may never turn out the same way twice, but it will still be DELICIOUS and folks will LOVE it!

Pour into ice cream tub and follow ice cream maker's directions. If you want my technique or have questions, just call me at 751-1226 & ask!

Raspberry seems to be the favorite flavor, but try it with chocolate or peaches and almond flavoring or strawberry or just about anything!




