2016 MAFCA National Convention



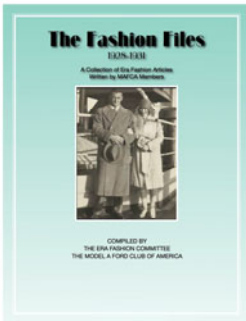

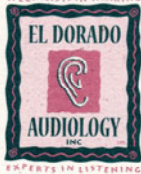


