FELLOWSHIP SQUARE CAR SHOW

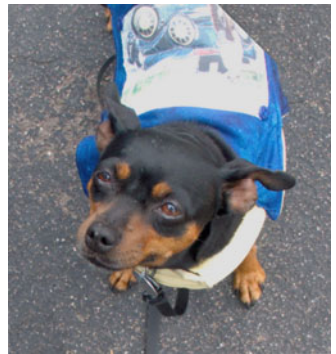
THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 8

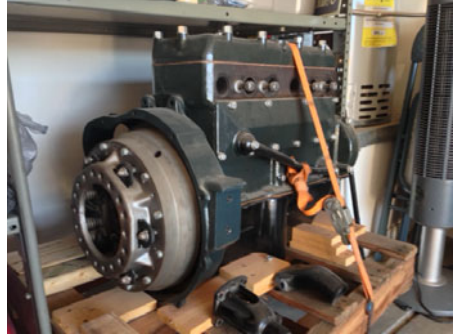
MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

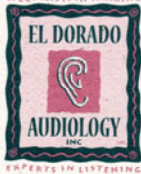


