Sunday June 25

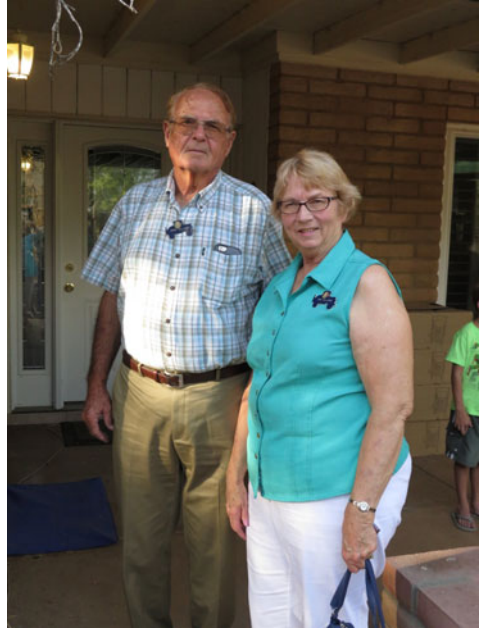
