

MAFCA NEWS



2017 MAFCA National Tour Pacific Coast Highway September 24 — 29



This is fourth in a series about the 2017 MAFCA National Tour, scheduled to take place September 24th thru 29th. This coastal California tour will start in Paso Robles and end in the Marin County town of San Rafael. Paso Robles is about 700 miles from Tucson. Once on the National Tour, we will spend two nights each in Paso Robles, the Monterey Bay area, and San Rafael.

The currently planned tour route bypasses the recent landslide at Mud Creek on Highway 1, so there are no additional changes to the Tour's previously planned detour around the bridge that was washed out earlier this year. Hearst Castle is still reachable from Paso Robles.

On the last day (day 6), a San Francisco tour is scheduled. What a deal for only 50 bucks! A bus will take us from the host hotel in San Rafael to the ferry terminal in Sausalito, where a chartered boat will take us to Fisherman's Wharf. En route, the boat will sail under the Golden Gate Bridge and around Alcatraz Island. Once in San Francisco, there are many attractions within easy walking distance. For example: Pier 39, Fisherman's Wharf, Hyde Street Pier Nautical Museum, Hyde Street Cable Car, Buena Vista Café (think Irish Coffee), and for

chocolate lovers, the famous Ghirardelli Square. Registration materials for the 2017 MAFCA tour are in the March/April issue of *The Restorer*.


