Davis-Monthan Boneyard Tour Sunday November 19




The final details for the Boneyard Tour at Davis-Monthan will be published in the October and November newsletters.

Jim's Tech Tip for September

Instrument Panel Light Too Bright?



I have always found the instrument panel light on my Model A to be too bright (and too hot! Ouch!). I would turn mine on for a few seconds, and then turn it right back off. Here is a simple fix: put a 12-volt, 3 candlepower tail light bulb in your 6 volt Model A instrument panel. That would be a #67 bulb, available at any auto parts store. Instead of being so bright, it will glow a nice, soft orange color because it's operating at half of the voltage it was designed for. Once your eyes get used to the dark, it gives all the light you need to see

the instruments. You will gladly leave it on for the entire night drive.

PS - the bulb number to do this on a car that has been converted to 12 volts is a #623 bulb. Harder to find, usually special order.




