Those that want to meet at the Village Inn at the corner East 22nd Street & South Harrison Road. We will be leaving at 10:30 AM.

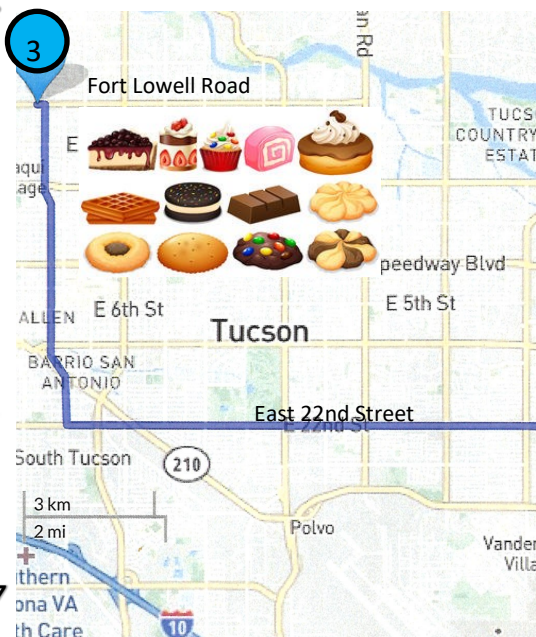
Stop #1 Christie & Steven Moon / = 3100 S. Quail Trail - Salads & Appetizers

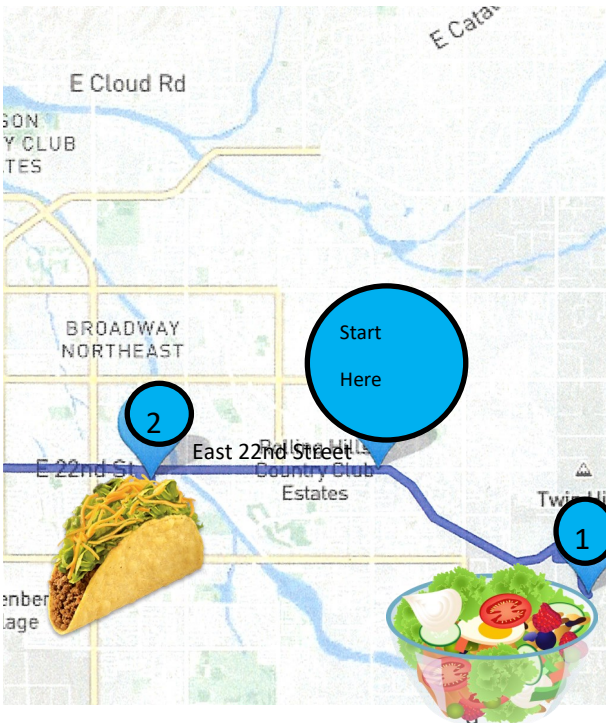

Leaving Stop #2 and going to Stop #3 can easily be achieved by getting yourself to the intersection of E. 22nd Street & Prudence Road and head west on E. 22nd Street for 7.3 miles and turn right onto S. Park Avenue until you reach E. Fort Lowell Road. (Park Avenue will turn into Euclid Avenue and then into 1st Avenue). Now make a left turn onto E. Fort Lowell Road for about 1/2 block and you'll see NIHOTO on your left. Now you have arrived at the final stop Stop #3 the Dessert Stop. Kick back and enjoy the Desserts, visit with friends and enjoy a tour of Andy's great car collection.

Be sure to bring your side dish to share with others. Christie has mentioned that she has refrigerator space available if you need to something cool between stops.
