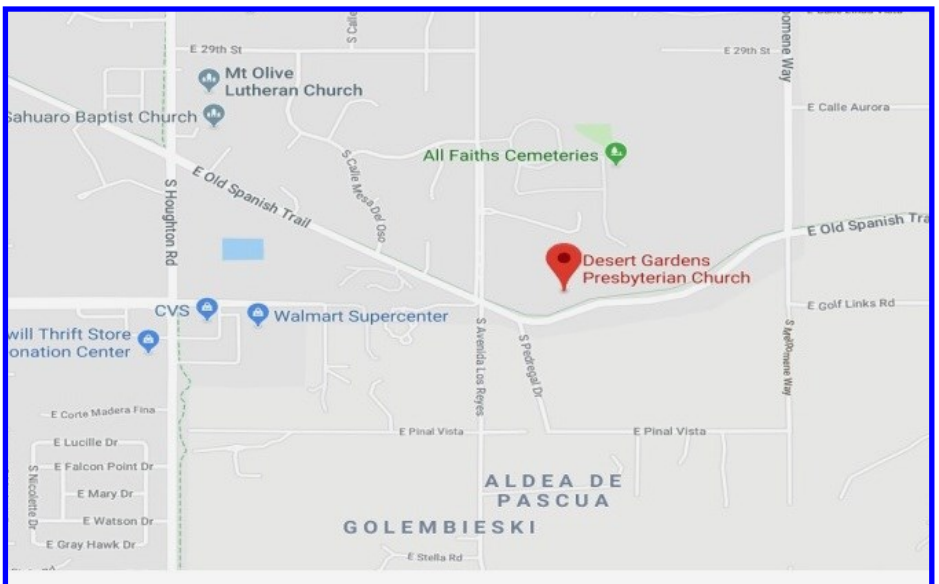

CARBURETOR TECHNICAL TALK

AUGUST 01, 2023

If you showed up early for the Model A club meeting, or if you were there for the Model T meeting, you would have been able to set in on the Technical Talk on carburetors presented by Fred Zumwalt. Fred is one of the Model A club members and was requested by the group to give his presentation to the group

Fred talked about the differences between the Model T and Model A carburetor and how the gas vapor makes it up to the combustion chamber.

Fred takes an old carburetor and cleans it, removing all the dirt, rust and gunk out of all the openings. He then replaces the valves and seats necessary, makes all of the adjustments necessary, and then test it out on his test engine. When all is said and done they run smoothly.

It will be nice to have him give the presentation to the A club members.

Fred has also donated a rebuilt carburetor for auction at the White Elephant Sale September 24th.




